

24/7 PRAYER GUIDE

10 Minutes – Fix your Eyes on God

“The supremacy of God in all things for the joy of all peoples.” –John Piper

Scripture: Psalm 96:3-4

Direction: Begin by exalting God for who He is, not what He does. Name his attributes: holy, sovereign, merciful, just, patient

Prayer Prompt (*this is meant to help you start*):

God, You are worthy of worship in Denver whether anyone turns to you or not. But you deserve to be known here.

10 Minutes – Clear the Ground

“A prayerless church is a powerless church.” –E.M. Bounds

Scripture: Psalm 51:10-12; 1 Peter 4:17

Direction: Confess personal sin, then corporate/church sin (ie. apathy, prayerlessness, fear of man)

Prayer Prompt (*this is meant to help you start*):

Lord, we are often more shaped by our city than surrendered to you in our city.

10 Minutes – Remember the Gospel

Scripture: Ezekiel 36:26-27; Titus 3:4-7

Direction: Rehearse what God does in salvation – He initiates, He rescues, He transforms.

Prayer Prompt:

God, you are the One who takes dead hearts and makes them alive. You have made me alive.”

15 Minutes – Intercede for the Lost

“If sinners be damned, at least let them leap to hell over our bodies.” –Charles Spurgeon

Scripture: Romans 10:1, 2 Corinthians 4:4

Direction: Pray specifically for:

- Friends, neighbors, coworkers by name
Your neighborhood, houses on your street
- Types of people: skeptical, indifferent, wealthy, broken, addicted

Prayer Prompts:

- That people would be drawn to FDC's Easter Services
- Open blind eyes
- Expose false beliefs
Interrupt with truth
- Cause people to feel the weight of their sin

15 Minutes – Pray for Easter invitations & Open Doors

Scripture: Colossians 4:3-4, Luke 14:23

Direction: Get practical & expectant

- Write down the names of the people you're inviting.
- Pray for those people.

Prayer Prompt:

- God, give me the courage to actually invite them.
- Go before me in that conversation. Prepare their hearts even now.
- Remove awkwardness, fear, and hesitation.
- Lord, make us unwilling to stay silent in a city that is far from you.
- Save them, Lord.

Remember, you cannot save anyone, but you can open your mouth.

End by surrendering to & trusting the Lord
